Description

The Redstone Rail Trail is located in East Longmeadow and connects two major destinations in the town. The wide and flat asphalt path connects town soccer fields, an industrial district with the center of town. The trail passes by fields, wetlands, and wooded areas, and has aerial photographs posted on signs throughout the trail that show the history of that particular location in East Longmeadow.

Location and Parking

From the rotary in the center of town travel $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west on Maple Street. From Shaker Road travel $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west on Denslow Road. From Connecticut, take exit 48 off of 91 to Route 220 northeast into Massachusetts, look left for Denslow Road. At the start of the trail on Denslow Road there is a parking lot. There is also a parking lot located a little bit further up the trail on Industrial Drive, which is off of Route 220.
